



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OSCE's assistance to Kyrgyzstan to promote digitalization: "Tunduk" - A single digital network



- Interconnection of state institutions through a single digital network;
- "Single window" services for citizens;
- Elimination of bureaucratic barriers;

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OSCE's assistance to Kyrgyzstan to promote digitalization: Open Government Partnership (OGP)




- Kyrgyzstan joined OGP in 2017;
- Kyrgyzstan is committed to make public administration more transparent and modern;
- OGP Secretariat is established and the OGP National Action Plan (NAP) 2019-2020 is developed.

OSCE's assistance to Kyrgyzstan to promote digitalization: Electronic Unified Crime Registry



- Interconnects police inspectorates, prosecutors and investigators electronically;
- Logging, and processing of criminal cases with efficiency and transparency.

OSCE's assistance to Kyrgyzstan to promote digitalization: International e-Business and e-Commerce Conference 1-2 Nov. 2018



- **130 participants** from Eurasian Economic Commission, the World Customs Organization, Central Asian states, EU, Russia, Georgia, Moldova, Belarus, public and private sectors.

- **Key recommendations:**

- Focus on customs procedures,
- Raising awareness among women, youth and rural citizens on digital market
- Development of necessary financial and logistical infrastructure,
- Consider security aspects of electronic platforms.

→ Creating the favourable policy and regulatory environment for e-business/e-commerce

→ Co-operation between government and private sectors in developing e-business and harmonization of legal frameworks and data protection.

→ Follow-up conference together with the WCO in 2019
