







Local strategies to prevent hate to date









Prijedor City Assembly councillors unanimously adopted on 15 March the first city Action Plan for prevention of and response to hate crimes and biasmotivated incidents, covering the period from 2017 until 2021. The Plan elaborates the roles and responsibilities of key stakeholders and outlines the required prevention plan and response activities.
