

Coalitions against Hate organized 60 events in 24 locations across BiH as part of the Week of Tolerance campaign aimed at encouraging citizen participation activities tolerance, promoting diversity, inter-ethnic cooperation, and inter-religious dialogue. The Campaign included sports and street exhibitions. events. competitions, meetings and conferences countering hate narratives and promoting reconciliation.

The Hate Monitor provides an update on all hate-motivated incidents and responses known to the OSCE Mission to BiH at the time of publishing the report each month
