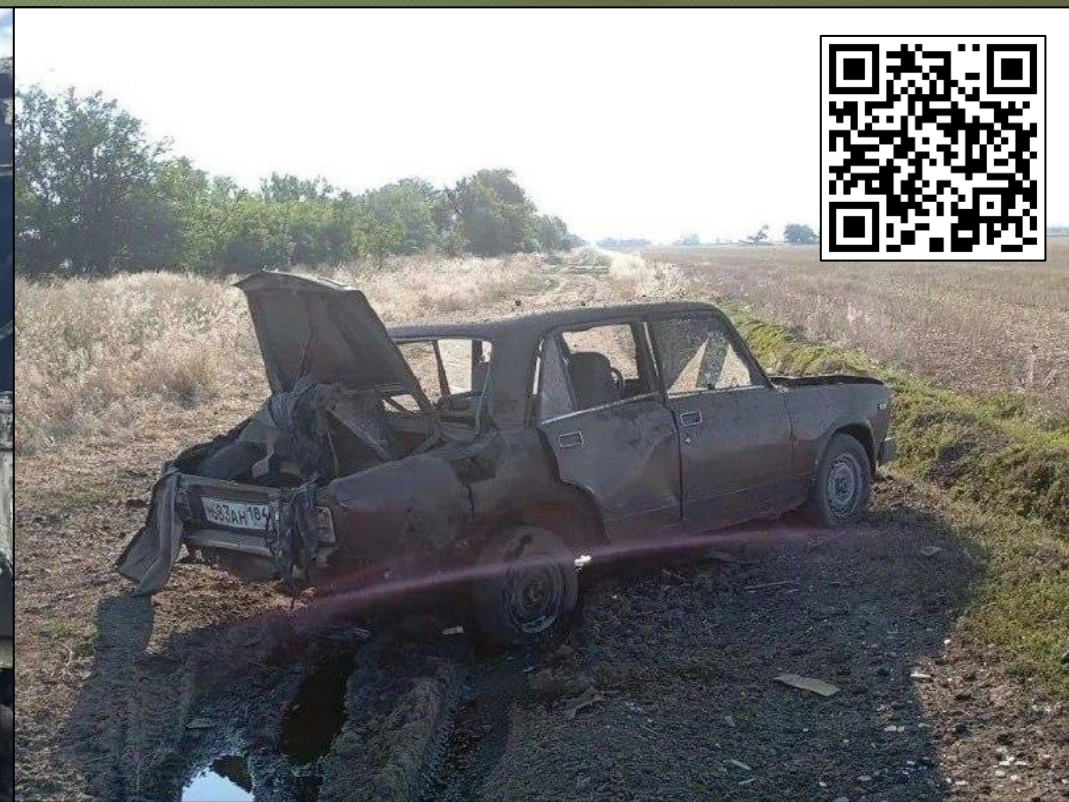

July 14 - a UAV attack targeted a parking area for civilian freight vehicles in Lugansk. While firefighters were extinguishing the blaze, EMERCOM personnel came under a second UAV strike. Three rescuers were injured.



July 15 - a civilian car struck a mine in the Alyoshki District of the Kherson Region.

July 15 - civilian vehicles were destroyed by fire following shelling of a residential area in Radensk, Kherson Region.



July 15 - a UAV struck a civilian car on a road near Schastye, LPR. Three civilians were killed and one was seriously injured.

July 16 - a UAV struck a civilian freight vehicle in Shebekino, Belgorod Region.



July 17 - a UAV struck an apartment building in Vasilyevka, Zaporozhye Region. Two women were injured.



July 19 - a UAV struck an apartment building in Kursk, Kursk Region.



July 19 - UAV struck a civilian car on the Urazovo-Gerasimovka road in the Belgorod Region.

July 17 - a UAV struck a civilian car on a road in the Kherson Region. One civilian was injured.

July 18 - a UAV attack targeted warehouses belonging to a commercial enterprise in Elektrostal, Moscow Region. One civilian was killed and 57 others were injured.

On July 19, the Russian army launched a massive strike with precision weapons against military industrial enterprises and logistics centers in Kiev.

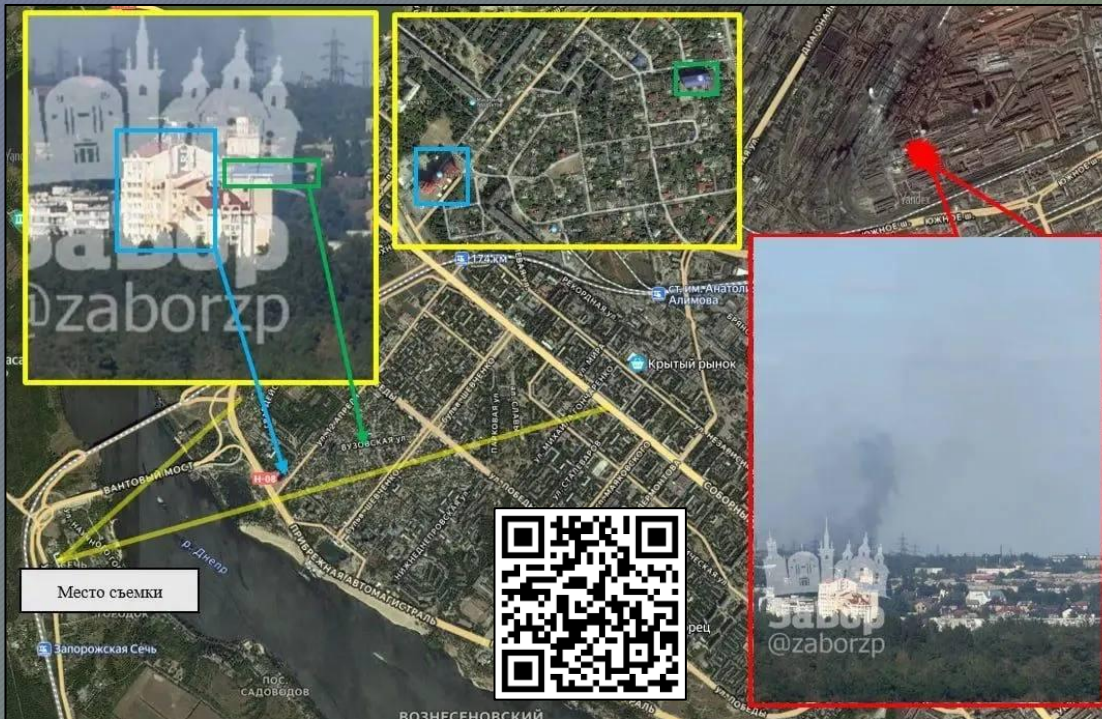
Military facilities affected:

- the Kiev radio-electronics enterprise (**Radioniks LLC**), which manufactures control systems for the FP-5 Flamingo cruise missile, FP-7 and FP-9 operational-tactical missiles, Neptune-MD guided missiles, and an analogue of the surface-to-air guided missiles of the S-300 air defence missile system (Project Klon). The enterprise is also engaged in the modernisation, technical maintenance and repair of onboard electro-optical targeting systems and airborne radars for MiG-29 aircraft;
- the Kiev rocket and space industry enterprise (**Spetsoboronmash LLC / Artem State Joint-Stock Holding Company**). It produces components of control systems for the FP-5 Flamingo cruise missile, FP-7 and FP-9 operational-tactical missiles, Neptune-MD guided missiles, and an analogue of the surface-to-air guided missiles of the S-300 air defence missile system (Project Klon);
- the **Kiev-90** manufacturing enterprise (Meridian named after Korolev LLC), which produces structural elements and components for guidance systems and various assemblies of Neptune-MD guided missiles;
- the **Oaklayn LLC**, Kiev. It manufactures components for long-range unmanned aerial vehicles of the Deep Strike type, produces carbon-fibre parts and batteries for FPV drones of various modifications, and also stores UAVs;
- the Kiev sorting centre (Kiev Innovation Terminal of Novaya Pochta), which is used for the delivery and storage of dual-use products including those intended for the production of UAVs, robotic systems, and electronic warfare equipment.

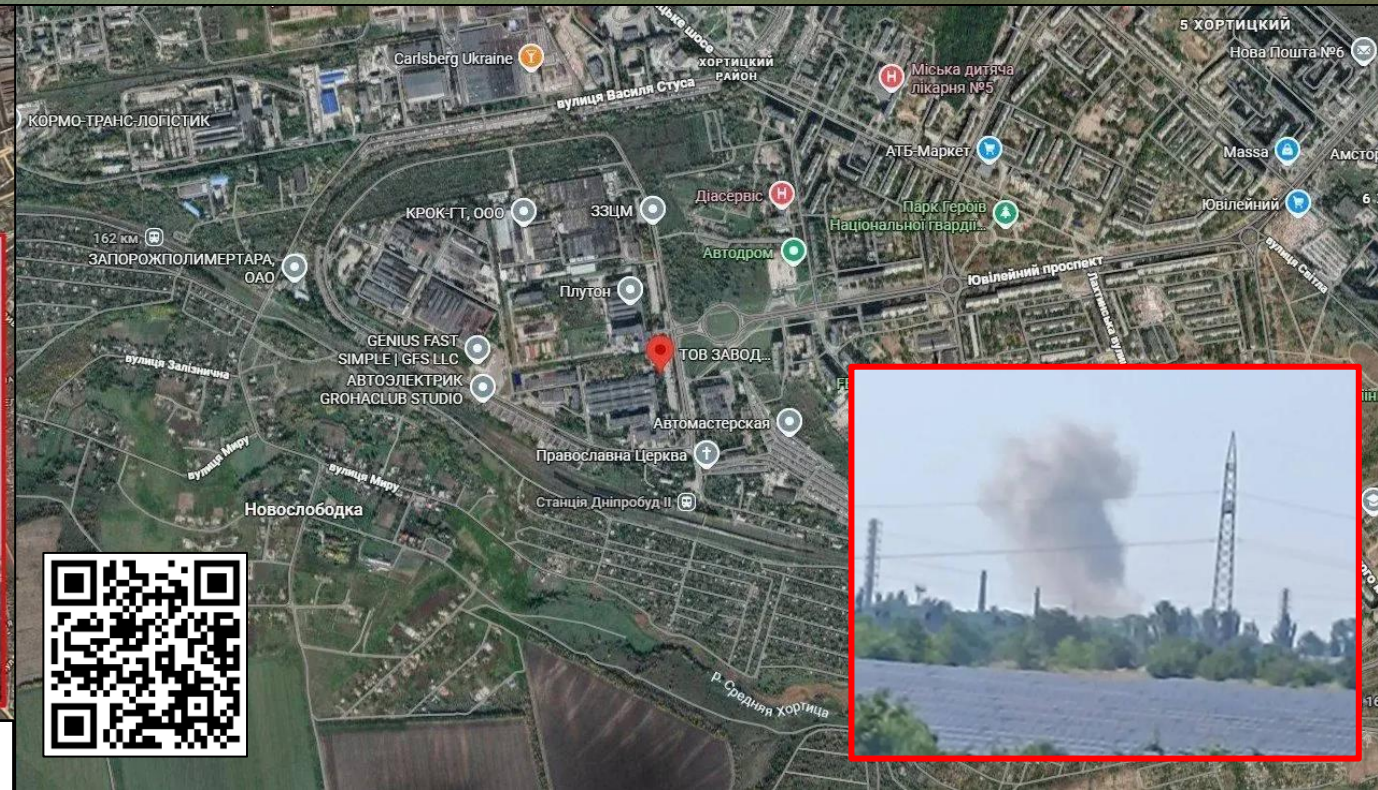
The following targets were reportedly struck in Kiev Region:

- the Tarasovka logistics centre (**Antel Properties**), which receives, stores, assembles, and distributes individual components and assemblies for the production of long-range unmanned aerial vehicles.

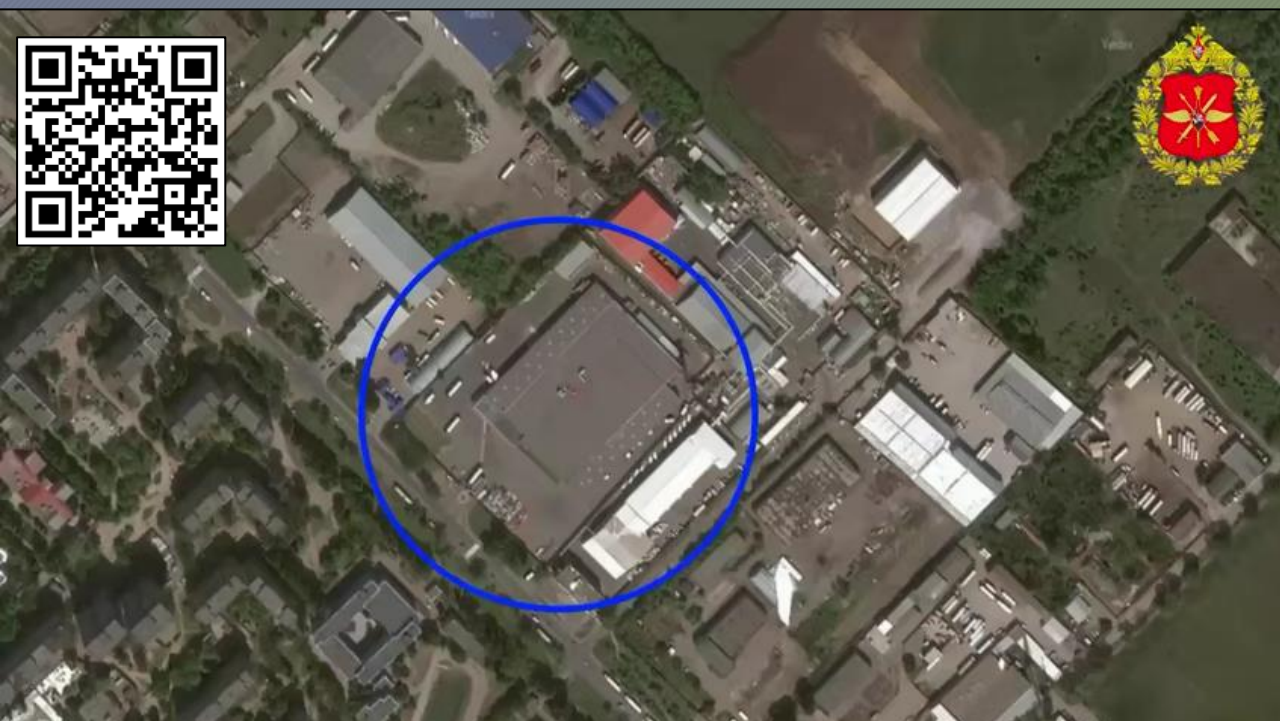


On July 19, the “Zaporozhstal” metallurgical plant, which supplied the AFU with bulletproof vests, protective helmets, steel, armored shields for equipment, mobile steel bunker-headquarters, and special engineering fortifications, came under a powerful attack from GBUs the day before.



On July 16, the “Vesna” electrical equipment plant in Zaporozhye, where Ukrainian Armed Forces drones were assembled, tested, and stored, was reduced to rubble. According to reports, it was hit by a powerful GBU strike.
